

Job Opportunity US Census Bureau

The Office of Statistical Methodology and Research (OSMREP) under the Associate Director for Economic Programs at the U.S. Census Bureau has posted a new GS-1529-14 position. The incumbent of this position will provide leadership, expertise and service in evaluations and measurement, especially in the area of data capture and response improvement for programs in the Economic Directorate, will lead the Evaluations and Measurement staff in OSMREP and will spearhead the effort to propose and research alternatives to response rates as measures of data quality.

The incumbent will develop or adapt mathematical theories, methods, techniques and approaches to evaluate, measure and improve the validity, quality and timeliness of economic programs; document work as a contribution to the literature; facilitate discussion with analysts including the scope of projects involving evaluations and measurement; develop methods and measurement metrics as needed to support evaluations in the Economic Directorate; initiate, plan and implement major statistical studies related to evaluations and measurement requiring the application and development of mathematical statistical theory; analyze and evaluate proposed projects and studies and establish technical guidelines for the conduct of mathematical statistical work related to data capture and response evaluations; develop and conduct training in evaluations and the use of measurement metrics; and manage assigned resources and review and evaluate proposed budgets.
