

The Data Files

The following data files are spreadsheets containing data developed from the 2007 Public Use detailed data release from the National Health Interview Survey. I thought this data might be of interest because it provides a detailed breakdown of communications lifestyle choice by age cohort. Also, the spreadsheets respond to the question: ***What is the impact of age and the presence of parents on household choice of communications lifestyle?*** Data file 2 is basically a supplement that provides a finer look at choices by age cohort.

The spreadsheets contain two different computations for cell-only penetration. The computation in bold type expresses penetration based on parental presence and age cohort while the second computation bases penetration solely on age cohort.
